

**** Lil Sweetheart ****

To fit 19-22" Reborn or 0-3 Months

ABBREVIATIONS

K:Knit, **P:**Purl, **st(s):**stitch(es), **st.st:**stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl), **Garter st:**Every row knit, **Rep:**Repeat, **s1k2p:**slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over, **inc:**increase, **alt:**alternate, **beg:**beginning, **tog:**together, **yfwd:**yarn forward, **M:**Main, **C:**Contrast, **ins:**inches.1 x 1 **Rib:** K1, P1, K1.

Requirements

200grams DK yarn (MAIN)
100grams DK yarn (CONTRAST)
12m Knit-in-Lace (Approx)
4 Buttons
Ribbon, Embellishments & Shirring Elastic
3.25mm & 4mm needles

USING KNIT-IN-LACE

HOLD LACE TO THE RS OF YOUR WORK WITH THE WS FACING YOU, K EACH ST TOG WITH ONE HOLE FROM LACE UNTIL YOU REACH END OF ROW. CUT OFF LACE TAKING CARE NOT TO CUT INTO ANY OF THE HOLES YOU HAVE KNITTED.

Main Pattern

Row 1: K2, *yfwd, K3, slip first of these 3sts over other 2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: P

Row 3: K1, *K3, slip first of these 3sts over the other 2, yfwd, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 4: P

MATINEE JACKET

Back

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 75sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Work in main pattern as given until back measures approx 6" ending with a p row.

DEC ROW: K4, *K2tog, rep from * to last 3sts, K3.

NEXT ROW: Purl. (41sts)

Leave these 41sts on spare needle for Yoke

Sleeves

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 42sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Work in main pattern until sleeve measures 5" end with a P row.

DECREASE ROW: K4, *K2tog, K2, rep from * to last 6sts, K2tog, K4. (33sts)

NEXT ROW: P

Leave sleeves on spare needle for Yoke.

Left Front

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 38sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Work in main pattern as follows, noting garter st border for front bands.

Row 1:Work 1st row of main pattern to last 5sts, K5.

Row 2:K5, P to end.

Row 3:Work 3rd row of main pattern to last 5sts, K5.

Row 4:K5, P to end.

Keeping garter st border correct work in pattern until front measures 6" approx.

DECREASE ROW: K2tog, rep from * to last 6sts, K6. (22sts)

NEXT ROW: K5, P to end.

Leave Left front on spare needles for Yoke.

Right Front

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 38sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Work in main pattern as follows, noting garter st border for front bands.

Row 1: K5, Work 1st row of main pattern to end.

Row 2: P to last 5sts, K5.

Row 3: K5, Work 3rd row of main pattern to end.

Row 4: P to last 5sts, K5.

Keeping garter st border correct work until front measures 6" approx.

DECREASE ROW: K6, *K2tog, rep from * to end.

NEXT ROW: Purl. (22sts)

YOKE

Using 4mm needles & right front with yarn still attached, K across 22sts from right front, 33sts from sleeve, 41sts from back, 33sts from sleeve, 22sts from left front. (151sts)

NEXT ROW: (WS):K5, Join in lace & work to last 5sts, K5 (without lace).

BUTTONHOLES for girls: (RS row)K2, yfwd, K2tog, work to end.

BUTTONHOLES for boys: (RS row)Work to last 3sts, yfwd, K2tog, work to end.

Make buttonholes (BH) as INSTRUCTED where indicated in following rows.

Row 1: (BH) K21, s1k2p, K30, s1k2p, K38, s1k2p, K30, s1k2p, K20

Row 2 & Alt rows: K5, P to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 3: K20, s1k2p, K28, s1k2p, K36, s1k2p, K28, s1k2p, K19.

Row 5: K19, s1k2p, K26, s1k2p, K34, s1k2p, K26, s1k2p, K18.

Row 7: K18, s1k2p, K24, s1k2p, K32, s1k2p, K24, s1k2p, K17.

Row 9: (BH) K17, s1k2p, K22, s1k2p, K30, s1k2p, K22, s1k2p, K16.

Row 11: K16, s1k2p, K20, s1k2p, K28, s1k2p, K20, s1k2p, K15.

Row 13: K15, s1k2p, K18, s1k2p, K26, s1k2p, K18, s1k2p, K14.

Row 15: K14, s1k2p, K16, s1k2p, K24, s1k2p, K16, s1k2p, K13.

Row 17: (BH) K13, s1k2p, K14, s1k2p, K22, s1k2p, K14, s1k2p, K12.

Row 19: K12, s1k2p, K12, s1k2p, K20, s1k2p, K12, s1k2p, K11.

Row 21: K11, s1k2p, K10, s1k2p, K18, s1k2p, K10, s1k2p, K10.

Row 23: K10, s1k2p, K8, s1k2p, K16, s1k2p, K8, s1k2p, K9

Row 25: As 2nd row.

Change to 3.25mm needles

NEXT ROW: (BH) Work b/hole as before, K to end.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT: K 3 rows. CAST OFF.

Join side & sleeve seams, match lace edgings.

Thread ribbon through eyelets as shown in photo's & embellish. Sew on buttons.

TROUSERS - Both Legs alike

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 45sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

NEXT: Working in main pattern, rep 3 times (12 rows) ending with 4th row of pattern.

NEXT: Break off M & join in C.

Starting K, work in st.st, inc 1st at each end of 5th & every following 6th until there are 55sts on needle.

Continue in st.st. Until work measures approx 7".

Break yarn leaving both legs on a spare needle.

Crotch to Waistband

Using 4mm needles & C, Cast on 4sts, K across 55sts from 1st leg, Cast on 8sts, K across 55sts from 2nd leg, Cast on 4sts. (126sts)

NEXT: Starting P, work in st.st. Until crotch measures approx 4½" finishing with a WS row.

DECREASE ROW: K10, K2tog (21 times), K20, K2tog (22times), K10. (83sts)

NEXT: Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work for approx 1½". Cast off

Join back seam for crotch, join leg seams. Thread shirring elastic through waistband if required. Thread ribbon through last row of eyelets in trouser legs, just below st.st.

BONNET

Using 3.25mm needles & M, Cast on 66sts.

NEXT: K 8 rows.

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row in lace.

Change to 4mm needles.

NEXT ROW: Knit.

NEXT ROW: K3, P to last 3sts, K3.

Work in main pattern, keeping 3sts at each end in garter st. Work until Bonnet measures 4" approx ending with P row.

NEXT ROW: K 2

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Shape Crown

Row 1: K6, K2tog, *K5, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 2 & Alt rows: P

Row 3: K5, K2tog, *K4, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 5: K4, K2tog, *K3, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 7: K3, K2tog, *K2, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 9: K2, K2tog, *K1, K2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 11: K1, *K2tog, rep from * to end. (11sts)

Break yarn & thread through remaining sts & draw up. Sew crown seam, joining end of lace. Sew on ribbon for neck tie & embellish as desired.

SHOES

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 29sts

INS: increase in next stitch.

Work sole shaping & increase.

1st row: K2, INS, K7, INS, K7, INS, K7, INS, K2

2nd row & alt rows: P

3rd row: K2, INS, K9, INS, K7, INS, K9, INS, K2

5th row: K2, INS, K11, INS, K7, INS, K11, INS, K2

7th row: K2, INS, K13, INS, K7, INS, K13, INS, K2

8th row: Purl. (45sts)

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row in lace.

NEXT: Starting K work 4 rows st.st.

Shape Instep

1st row: K26, K2tog t.b.l, turn

2nd row: sl1, P7, P2tog, turn

3rd row: sl1, K7, K2tog t.b.l, turn

4th row: As 2nd row

Rep last 2 rows until 31 sts remain

Next row: sl1, K to end.

Next row: P to end.

Next row: K 1 row.

Next row: Work 1 row in lace.

Work 6 rows in garter st, Cast off.

Sew back & sole seam taking care to match ends of lace. Sew on embellishments as required.

BOTTLE COVER

I recommend you measure the height of individual bottles due to the large number of different ones available, 2 sizes are included below.

Normal Tall Bottle approx 7" around.
Wide neck Small Bottle approx 9" around.

Using 4mm needles & M, Cast on 33(42)sts.

NEXT: K 2 rows

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row of lace.

NEXT ROW: K

NEXT ROW: P

Work in main pattern as follows -

Row 1: K2, *yfwd, K3, slip first of these 3sts over other 2, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: P

Row 3: K1, *K3, slip first of these 3sts over the other 2, yfwd, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.

Row 4: P

Continue in pattern until work measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ ($6\frac{1}{2}$)" ending with a P row. Adjust height here if required.

NEXT ROW: K 1 row.

NEXT ROW: Work 1 row in lace.

WIDE NECK BOTTLE ONLY

Starting K, Work 2 rows st.st.

For both type bottles continue as follows -

Dec for bottom.

NEXT ROW: *K2, K2tog, rep from * to last 1(2)sts, K1(K2).

NEXT ROW: P

NEXT ROW: *K1, K2tog, rep from * to last 1(2)sts, K1(2).

NEXT ROW: P

NEXT ROW: *K2tog, rep from * to end. (9sts)

Break yarn & thread through remaining sts, draw up, sew bottom seam, sew up side seam taking care to match ends of lace.

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
